



Henderson Leads Lions with Third-Place Finish; Women Finish Eighth Overall

Junior **Sunny Henderson** (*pictured*) finished third in the javelin as the Texas A&M University-Commerce women's track and field team competed in the final day of competition of the Lone Star Conference Championships in San Angelo, Texas.

Henderson finished the event with a best throw of 37.48 meters (122-11), just .3 meters (one foot) away from the second-place finisher.

In the 100-meter dash, sophomore **Charnita Hollands** finished seventh in 12.32, a season-best time due to inaccurate times in yesterday's 100-meter dash preliminaries. Hollands finishes the season as the Lions' top female sprinter.

In the 1,500-meter run, freshman **Jennifer Speer** and junior **Kate Donovan** finished in 13th and 17th place, respectively, with times of 5:21.33 and 5:26.98. Speer's time represents a season-best performance of more than 10 seconds.

The Lions finished the meet with 13 points, placing eighth.
